




SCREED LEVELLING PINS

A time and cost effective method of precisely levelling new sub floors or existing uneven floors.



OVERVIEW

TEKCEM SCREED LEVELLING PINS are a simple yet ingenious tool used to ensure that a floor is laid to exactly the correct desired level.

Traditionally, the levelling of floors has been done via laborious methods - e.g. drilling, plugging and screwing mounting screws into the floor – or even worse: by rule of thumb!

The TEKCEM SCREED LEVELLING PIN method of levelling provides increased accuracy at a significant cost saving.

BENEFITS

- · Lightweight, portable
- · Easy-to-read millimetre and inch scale
- · Easy to cut using scissors or sharp blade
- · Bright colour makes them easily visible
- · Heavy duty adhesive backing reduces risk of movement
- · Covering paper easily detaches from self-adhesive tape

METHOD

- $\cdot\;$ Apply TEKPRIME primer as per manufacturers instruction
- · Carefully measure and mark the floor
- Cut the levelling pin to the desired height, using the moulded millimetre or inch rule along the pin as a guide
- Peel off the self adhesive backing from the base of the pin and adhere the pin to the floor, applying firm even pressure
- Apply the concrete or screed until it just about covers the top of the pin
- · Lightly trowel flat to finish
